Dear Sisters and Brothers in the Lord:

"With such affection for you, we were determined to share with you not only the gospel of God, but our very selves as well, so dearly beloved had you become to us." (1 Thess. 2:8)

Already the time has come for me to leave; in fact, my day of departure from Anderson may have already taken place, this past Friday, by the time you are reading this. For three months I have been able to be with you—to live among you, to learn from you, and to be impacted by you. How quickly the three months have passed!

It seems to me only yesterday that I was writing my introduction in the bulletin, while now—so soon!—I write this note of farewell. I must move on from St. Ambrose and St. Mary parishes here in Anderson, in order to continue my formation towards the priesthood.

I have still two more years of prayer, study, and work. And, as much as I would like to stay with you all, I must take Jesus' words to heart: "But I tell you the truth, it is better for you that I go. For if I do not go, the Advocate will not come to you. But if I go, I will send him to you" (John 16:7).

Without Jesus' departure from the apostles, the Holy Spirit ("the Advocate") would not have come upon them; without my departure from you, I will not be able to receive the Holy Spirit's work in the Sacrament of Holy Orders.

So it is that I must go forth with intermingling sorrow and joy; but above all this, a deep and abiding gratitude. When

I arrived here at St. Ambrose and St. Mary parishes, I was eager to come to know you: to learn about your lives, to encounter your experiences, to come to know your needs and desires for your priests—in short, to share my very self with you and to receive from you, in turn, the gifts of yourselves. And how generously you have given to me more than I could have ever expected!

Thank you. Though I could never thank you all enough for your witness of faith, your fidelity to God and His Church, and your gracious encouragement, still I say 'thank you'. During my time here, so very many of you have indeed become 'dearly beloved' to me. Thank you for inviting me to 'come and see' your lives.

From here, I will spend 11 weeks at IU Health North Hospital in Carmel, Indiana; afterwards, I will return to Mundelein Seminary to continue studying Theology. And although I leave all of you, this is not so much 'goodbye', as 'see you later': if not on this side of eternity, then in the Heavenly Kingdom; and always, let us meet in the Eucharist—that privileged moment when Christ draws us all together into Communion with Him and with each other.

Soup Kitchen Menu "For I was Hungry and you gave me Food." (Mt 25:35) The Catholic Community of Anderson encourages **everyone to bring any of the following food items** to Church and place them in baskets during the weekend Masses on May 19th & 20th. Ingredients needed are: 14.5 oz. can, diced tomatoes; 15.5 or 30.5 oz. cans of Chili Hot Beans; Onions; 8 oz. box of spaghetti; 3 oz. cans of Chili powder; Quart or gallon size cans of fruit; 1 lb. packages of frozen group beef; packages of American cheese or, boxes of saltine crackers.

During the month of May, we will be preparing 20 gallons of Chili for the Women and Children at Alternatives; and the men of the Christian Center plus those from the community who will dine separately at the Center. That is about 300 bowls of chili. Your generosity will be greatly appreciated. The meal will be served on May 30th.

DESDE EL PASTOR

Queridas Hermanas y Hermanos en el Señor:

"Y es tal nuestro cariño que quisiéramos, junto con entregarles el Evangelio, entregarles también nuestra propia vida, porque han pasado a ser muy queridos nuestros." (1-Tesalonicenses 2,8)

Ha venido ya el tiempo para despedirme; en realidad, el día de mi salida ya ocurrió, porque tuve que salir este viernes pasado. Por tres meses yo he estado con ustedes—viviendo entre ustedes, aprendiendo de ustedes, y creciendo en cariño por todos ustedes. ¡Y que rápidamente pasaron estos tres meses! A mí me parece que hubiera solamente ayer que estaba escribiendo mi introducción por el boletín, y ahorita—¡tan pronto!—estoy escribiendo una mensaje de salida.

Tengo que irme de las parroquias de San Ambrosio y Sta. María aquí en Anderson para continuar mi formación al sacerdocio; todavía tengo dos años más de oración, estudio, y trabajo hasta pueda yo venir a mi ordinación al sacerdocio. Y, aunque me gustaría tanto quedarme aquí con todos ustedes, tengo que seguir mi vocación y las palabras de Jesús: "En verdad, les conviene que yo me vaya, porque si no me voy, el Intercesor no vendrá a ustedes. Pero si me voy, se lo mandaré" (Juan 16,7). Si Jesús no despidió a sus apóstoles, el Espíritu Santo ('el Intercesor') no pudiera venir a ellos; si yo no despido de ustedes, nunca podré recibir el Espíritu Santo en el Sacramento del Orden.

Entonces, tengo que ir. Y me voy con una mezcla de tristeza y alegría; pero, sobre todo, una gratitud profunda. Cuando vine aquí en San Ambrosio y Sta. María, estaba yo emocionado para conocerles a ustedes: aprender sobre sus vidas, saber sus experiencias, y escuchar a sus deseos para sus sacerdotes—en efecto, compartir mi propia vida con ustedes y recibir de ustedes, en torno, el don de sus vidas.

¡Y que generosamente han dado ustedes más que pudiera yo esperar!

Entonces: Gracias. Aunque nunca pueda yo agradecerles suficientemente para su testimonio de la fe, su fidelidad a Dios y Su Iglesia, y sus palabras de aliento, todavía quiero decirles: 'muchas gracias'. Durante mis tres meses aquí, de veras, muchos de ustedes han sido 'muy queridos' a mí. Gracias por invitarme a 'venir y ver' sus vidas.

Próximo, pasaré 11 semanas en el hospital IU Health North en Carmel, Indiana; después, regresaré a Mundelein Seminary para continuar mis estudios de Teología. Y, aunque salga yo de ustedes, no es decir 'adiós' por siempre, tanto como 'hasta la próxima'; y espero que la próxima vez sea en este lado de la eternidad; pero si así no es, en cielo nos veamos. Y, como siempre, nos reunamos en la Eucaristía—en aquel momento especial cuando Cristo nos congrega todos juntos en Comunión con Él y con nosotros, uno a otro.
